Bwyd Powys Food is the Sustainable Food Partnership for Powys. The partnership is hosted at Cultivate and employs two coordinators, one for the North and one for the South of the county.

Role of the Bwyd Powys Food Partnership

- Motivating wider stakeholders to engage with Action Planning & Strategy
- Raising the profile of the Partnership and Action Plan
- Setting up and receiving reports from subgroups on particular themes

- Helping develop more effective ways of getting things done
- Maintaining energy and enthusiasm

These strategic partners ensure balanced representation from key public, private, third and community sector organisations and networks.

New steering group members are invited and proposed to the existing partnership.

Bwyd Powys Food Partnership meetings will be minuted, with a focus on actions agreed and a named person(s) responsible for leading on each action.

Members of the Bwyd Powys Food Partnership are able to apply for and receive funds administered by Bwyd Powys Food for the delivery of activities and services.
